

Check This Out!

The IRS is offering a \$2,000 Home Energy Tax Credit for home-builders one each qualifying energy efficient home sold in 2006 & 2007.

The Builders Association of Minnesota (BAM) has created a team and a single 3-step system to test and certify qualifying houses, making the process to collect the tax credit as easy as possible.

The No Risk First Step:

When you call BAM to schedule a home for testing, they will walk you through a quick set of questions to determine the likelihood that your home(s) will pass. If there is a good chance, they will schedule the first testing session.

Minimal Investment Step II:

For a tax-deductible business expense of \$300 (members) \$500 (nonmembers) a tester will evaluate your floorplan. If your home passes this first test, it is likely that it and your other homes will qualify.

Final Investment Step III:

For a final tax-deductible business expense of \$695, a BAM tester will visit your home to conduct phase II testing. When your house passes this test, the results are sent to our certifier who will verify the data and send you the necessary tax form to claim the \$2,000 credit.
