ORDINANCE NO.773 2ND SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 7.01, 7.07, AND 7.14 FOR THE PURPOSES OF CLARIFYING THE REGULATIONS FOR ON-STREET PARKING OF TRAILERS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section I. That Section 7.01 of the Alexandria City Code is hereby amended by the deletion of the existing language and the insertion of the following:

Section 7.01 <u>Definitions</u>. The definitions of terms used in this Chapter shall be those definitions set forth in Minn. Stat. § 168.002, as amended, and Minn. Stat. § 169.011, as amended, as well as those definitions contained herein.

Subd. 1. Recreational vehicle.

- a. "Recreational vehicle" means travel trailers including those that telescope or fold down, chassismounted campers, motor homes, tent trailers, and converted buses that provide temporary human living quarters.
- b. "Recreational vehicle" is a vehicle that:
 - 1) is not used as the residence of the owner or occupant;
 - 2) is used while engaged in recreational or vacation activities; and
 - 3) is either self-propelled or towed on the highways incidental to the recreational or vacation activities. (Source: Minnesota Statutes 2006, 168.011.
- Subd. 2. **Trailer** "Trailer" means any vehicle designed for carrying property or passengers on its own structure and for being drawn by a motor vehicle but does not include a trailer drawn by a truck-tractor semitrailer combination or an auxiliary axle on a motor vehicle which carries a portion of the weight of the motor vehicle to which it is attached.
- **Section II.** That Section 7.07 of the Alexandria City Code is hereby amended by the deletion of the existing language and the insertion of the following:
- Section 7.07. Recreational Vehicle Parking and Trailer Parking. It is unlawful for any person to leave or park any recreational vehicle, as defined herein, on or within the limits of any street or right of way, except where signs are erected designating the place as a campsite, for more than twenty-four (24) hours. It is unlawful for any person to leave or park any trailer, detached from its towing vehicle, on or within the limits of any street or right of way.
- **SECTION III**. That Section 7.14, Subdivision 5 of the Alexandria City Code is hereby amended by the deletion of the existing language and the insertion of the following:
- Subd. 5. **Semitrailer Parking**. It is unlawful to park a semitrailer upon any public right-of-way, alley, or street except when engaged in loading and unloading operations.
- **SECTION IV.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
