

ALEXANDRIA COMMUNITY TELEVISION

Program Submission Policy Approved 8/17/10

The City of Alexandria and Independent School District 206 provide the public with a process to submit programs for playback on the designated public access channel (Channel 7). Air time will be available to any person, group, organization or entity consistent with the following guidelines;

PROHIBITED PROGRAMMING

- 1. Advertising material designed to directly promote the sale of commercial and retail products or services
- 2. Programs, productions or presentations involving obscene, indecent, or such material that violates any local, state, or federal law
- 3. Lottery or lottery information
- 4. Direct solicitation of funds, except for the promotion of fundraising events
- 5. Promotion by or on behalf of any legally qualified candidate

TECHNICAL STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Programming must meet minimum quality standards for cablecasting.
- 2. The nominal length for a "half hour" program is 28:30; 58:30 for a "one-hour" slot. Shorter running times can be accommodated, but long-format programs (exceeding 1 hour) may take longer to schedule.
- 3. All media supplied for cablecasting must be in the following formats:
 - a. DVD is either the –R or +R format.
 - b. All tapes should be submitted in standard play speed.
- 4. All programs must be accurately timed and labeled on the DVD and storage case with:
 - a. The producer's name.
 - b. The program name or title
 - c. The total running time to the nearest second
 - d. Any additional relevant information, such as dated material, or queing instructions.

OTHER GUIDELINES AND RULES

- Request for air time should be made to the Assistant City Administrator on a Cablecast Request Form (available at <u>www.ci.alexandria.mn.us</u>) at least one week prior to the date requested. Groups and individuals may use one of the following means to submit their Cablecast Request Form:

- 2. Last minute requests for program time will be considered in special situations. In those cases, staff will attempt to accommodate requests as quickly as possible
- 3. All access programming will be on a first-come, first served non-discriminatory basis. Stand-alone programs in excess of one minute may be scheduled on the access channel a maximum of eight (8) times in a four-week period.

- 4. Alexandria Community Television will not edit, or alter in any way, the content of any program submitted for cablecasting; however, if it is determined that the program contains material that is in violation with these rules, the program will not be cablecast.
- 5. Programs containing material meeting the guidelines of TV-MA as defined in the following link (<u>www.fcc.gov/parents/parent_guide.html/</u>) will be preceded by a message advising viewer discretion and will only be scheduled between the hours of 11:00 PM and 4:00 AM. Channel users are responsible for notifying Alexandria Community Television on the Cablecast Request Form if their program contains material requiring an advisory message.
- 6. All content is the responsibility of the producer. Except for the programming they submit themselves, neither the City of Alexandria nor Alexandria School District 206 will be responsible for the content of any programming submitted for cablecasting by any other producer.
- 7. Individuals submitting programs must make all necessary arrangements with and obtain required clearances and licenses from broadcast stations, networks, sponsors, music licensing organizations, composers, etc. Producers shall be solely responsible for copyright, trademark, invasion of privacy, libel, slander, defamation, and all other violations resulting from their programming.
- 8. Producers will agree to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Alexandria and Independent School District 206, and their respective staffs from any liability or other injury (including cost of defense) which may result from any production.
- 9. Disputes arising from use of public access time shall be resolved by the Alexandria Cable TV Commission.
