Trainings

Monday Nights, 5:30 pm dinner, 6 – 9 pm Required: MINIMUM of 70% of Drills

12 hours of Continuing Education Outside Instruction (usually a weekend at a Fire School or Fire Conference). Per Diem of \$ 110 per day of school issued.

Fire Calls

200 - 225 per year (approx. 60 structure, 30 extrication, 60 False Alarm, the rest made up of vehicle fire, grass, special rescue, good intent, searches, mutual aid, other; we try to cancel alarms as quickly as information allows so response can be cancelled & can get back to work with little disruption.)

Duration of call is dependent on call. Alarms: 10 – 20 minutes; vehicle: 30 minutes; room/contents: 1-1 ½ hours; full structure: 2+ hours.

Community Events

We're asked to have a presence at approx. 80+ community events throughout the year (e.g. Community Night Out, Op Grad, Douglas County Fair, School Escorts, Expos, 9/11, School Drills). Most firefighters make approx. of 10 events.

MANDATORY Pork & Corn Feed (most of day in August) and Fire Prevention Open House (October evening).

Details

Must live within 10 minutes of Fire Station.

First year, in addition to Monday night trainings, EMR training (2 nights/week for 6 weeks + Firefighter 1 training - 2 nights/week & 2 Saturdays for about 6 weeks).

Year 1 is Probation, after year 1 considered Active & issued Firefighter plates.

CDL License (Class B) - recommended possess by year 5.

All Personal Safety gear is provided, Class A uniform provided, AFD wear provided.

This is a volunteer department; No Paid on Call.

Relief Association membership (Currently 10 years of service 60% vested, then 4 % every year after, 100% vested at 20 years of service.)

Random Drug Testing approx. quarterly
