SECTION III: That this Ordinance provides for reimbursement to LaGrand Township of the property taxes payable to said Township in the following manner: The Township share of property taxes as of the effective date of this Ordinance is \$210.92 which the Township shall retain for 2020. The City shall provide reimbursement to include 50% (\$105.46) of that share in 2021 and 50% (\$105.46) of that share in 2022, which shall be the final year of such reimbursement.
