

**ORDINANCE NO. 837**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 4.35, SUBDIVISION 5 AND  
SUBDIVISION 7 RELATING TO TRANSIENT MERCHANTS**

The City Council of the City of Alexandria does **ORDAIN**:

**SECTION I.** That Section 4.35, Subdivision 5 of the Alexandria City Code is hereby amended by deleting Subdivision 5 in its entirety.

**SECTION II.** That Section 4.35, Subdivision 7 of the Alexandria City Code is hereby amended by deleting A and B and with the following language:

Subd. 7. **Exceptions.** This section shall not apply to any sale under court order, nor to any bona fide auction sale, nor to newspaper delivery, nor to sale at wholesale to retail dealer in the articles sold, nor to the sale of farm or garden products by the person producing the same, nor sales of admissions by local school students to a school function. Nor shall this Section apply to solicitations for philanthropic, religious, and educational charitable causes.


**SECTION III.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.

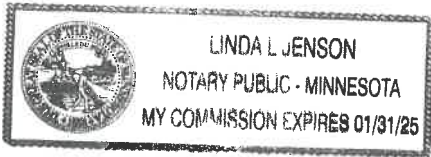



The City Council of the City of Alexandria does **ORDAIN:**

**SECTION I.** That Section 4.35, Subdivision 5 of the Alexandria City Code is hereby amended by deleting Subdivision 5 in its entirety.

**SECTION II.** That Section 4.35, Subdivision 7 of the Alexandria City Code is hereby amended by deleting A and B and with the following language:

Subd. 7. **Exceptions.** This section shall not apply to any sale under court order, nor to any bona fide auction sale, nor to newspaper delivery, nor to sale at wholesale to retail dealer in the articles sold, nor to the sale of farm or garden products by the person producing the same, nor sales of admissions by local school students to a school function.
