AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 5.05 RELATING TO MECHANICAL CONTRACTORS/INSTALLERS

The City Council of the City of Alexandria does **ORDAIN**:

SECTION I. That Section 5.05, Subdivision 8.2 of the Alexandria City Code is hereby amended by deleting the current renewal fee of \$50 and replacing it with \$100 to match the fee outlined in the annual fee schedule adopted by the City Council as follows:

2. Fees:

a. Mechanical contractor's license	
Initial fee	\$100.00
Renewal fee	\$100.00
b. Journeyman and apprentice mechanic's license	
Initial fee	\$10.00
Renewal fee	\$10.00

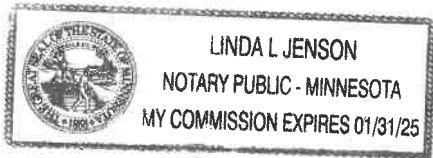


